"Wow", says Tom, **"when I grow up, I want to be as tall as a giraffe so that I can reach the cookie jar!"**

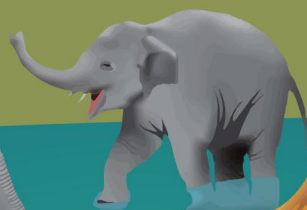
This makes mummy and daddy laugh.
